RECIPE CORNER



Mini Pumpkin Spice Trifles

1 cup all-purpose flour
1 tbsp. instant espresso powder
1 tsp. baking powder
1 tsp. ground cinnamon
½ tsp. baking soda
½ tsp. salt
½ tsp. nutmeg
½ tsp ground allspice
1 cup canned pumpkin
¾ cup sugar
½ cup canola oil
2 large eggs, room temperature
Filling:
6 oz. cream cheese, softened
¼ cup butter, softened
1 tsp. vanilla extract
2-¾ cups confectioners' sugar
Additional ground cinnamon,
optional

Preheat oven to 350 degrees. Whisk together the first 8 ingredients. In another bowl, beat pumpkin, sugar and oil until smooth; add eggs, one at a time, beating well after each addition. Gradually add flour mixture; beat until well blended.

Line a 9-in. square baking pan with parchment; grease paper. Pour in batter. Bake until a toothpick inserted in center comes out clean, about 20 minutes. Cool in pan 10 minutes on a wire rack. Remove from pan; cool completely on wire rack.

For filling, beat cream cheese, butter and vanilla until blended. Gradually beat in confectioners' sugar until smooth. To assemble, cut cake into ½ inch cubes. In 8 juice glasses or small parfait glasses, alternate layers of cake and filling, ending with filling. If desired, sprinkle with additional cinnamon. Enjoy!
